Save the Children is implementing programs in Bolivia directly and with partners and stakeholders, so that all children will attain their rights to survive, learn and be protected from harm. Our approach focuses on comprehensive child development and child participation.

OUR WORK

Education: we seek to ensure that children have access to high quality basic education services and focus our efforts on comprehensive early childhood care and development.

Child Rights Governance: we work with national and local governments to ensure compliance with the Convention on the Rights of the Child. We also advocate for legislation to protect children's rights and to increase public investment in children.

Protection: we strengthen child protection systems so children can live in an environment free from violence and exploitation. We work towards eliminating all forms of physical and humiliating punishment of children in the home and school.

Poverty Reduction: we promote policies and advocate to reduce child poverty, and implement programs on adolescent skill-development in order to enable them to make a successful transition to adulthood.

Health & Nutrition: we work to eliminate child mortality from preventable causes, promote access to sexual and reproductive health for adolescents, and seek to ensure equitable access to health care and nutrition for the most vulnerable children.

IMPROVING NUTRITION AND SCHOOL HEALTH IN BOLIVIA



GOAL

Improve the health and nutrition of 25,000 children of preschool and primary school between 3 and 13 years in the cities of Oruro and La Paz.

IMPACT

- 12,854 boys
- 12,146 girls
- 3,000 parents and caregivers
- 600 teachers
- 50 health professionals

PERIOD

3 years

EDUCATION AND SPORTS, DEVELOPING MY SKILLS



GOAL

Getting children and adolescents between 10 and 16 years in the municipalities of La Paz and El Alto to improve their learning and develop their skills using sports to achieve their full potential.

IMPACT

- 10,000 children from 16 primary schools and 14 high schools
- 4,000 parents
- 800 teachers, principals, administrative or service personnel

PERIOD

1 year

GIRLS LIVING AT ALTITUDE: SPORTS FOR DEVELOPMENT IN BOLIVIA

GOAL

Raise awareness of the rights of adolescents, promote gender equality and empower teenagers who join groups and/or social activities, and support their development through their participation in soccer, basketball and volleyball teams.

IMPACT

- 600 adolescent girls ages 12-18
- 3,000 boys and girls (indirectly)
- 15 trained coaches
- 30% of adolescents were able to distribute their time between school, sports and leisure.
- 13% of the participating adolescent girls were able to better express their wishes and needs to their families and communities.
- 6% of adolescent girls more empowered as women and equal with men.
